

NORTH EAST TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
MEETING
MONDAY APRIL 6, 2026
7:30 PM

Chairman Russ LaFuria called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also, in attendance were Supervisors August Neff and Fredrick Shunk, Attorney Andy Schmidt, and Secretary Erica Carlstrom.

Chairman LaFuria asked for public comments or concerns, none were received. A motion from Fredrick Shunk and the second from August Neff approved the minutes of the March 16th, 2026, meeting as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Secretary Erica Carlstrom presented the Treasurer's report for the month of March 2026 and by a motion from August Neff and the second from Russ LaFuria was accepted as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Bills were presented for March 16th – March 31st, 2026, for approval and payment as follows:

Total approved by a motion from Fredrick Shunk and the second from August Neff was \$254,097.83 and passed by unanimous vote.

Correspondence:

A request was received from the National Grape Co-Op for the use of the meeting room. They would like Thursday May 14th the meeting will take place at 6:30 PM. August Neff made a motion to approve the meeting. The second motion received from Fredrick Shunk. All in favor.

New Business:

Erin Giroux presented a request to the Board of Supervisors to post an American Sign Language informational poster at Freeport Beach. She explained the request is in memory of her daughter, who was deaf and tragically passed away in a drowning incident.

Jen Rodenbaugh, representing Enjoy North East, requested approval from the Board of Supervisors to hold the annual Fourth of July celebration at the Gravel Pit Park. She stated the event would remain consistent with previous years, with the addition of security due to an anticipated increase in attendance in recognition of America's 250th anniversary. Ms. Rodenbaugh also requested that the park restrooms be locked for the day, noting prior issues with clogged facilities, and indicated that portable toilets would be provided. The Supervisors discussed the request and left the decision regarding the restroom closure to Enjoy North East. Ms. Rodenbaugh stated she will provide the Township with a certificate of insurance and a signed agreement with Fuller Hose for use of the park.

Bids for the Damsite Road Culvert Replacement Project were opened and read on April 2nd, 2026. Bids were as follows:

A motion from August Neff and the second from Russ LaFuria approved awarding McLallen Construction with the contract. Passed by unanimous vote.

Jack Diorazio III, North East Township EMC is seeking approval of the revised Emergency Operations Plan. Supervisor Fredrick Shunk stated he had not received a copy and would like a chance to read it before approving the document. A motion from Fredrick Shunk to table the signing of the resolution until the May 4th meeting was made. August Neff made the second motion. All in favor.

After announcements and with all business concluded, a motion to adjourn at 8:00 PM was received from Fredrick Shunk. Meeting Adjourned.
