MEETING
MONDAY, JULY 21, 2025

Chairman Russ LaFuria called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also in attendance were Supervisors Fredrick Shunk and August Neff along with Attorney Tim Wachter and Secretary Erica Carlstrom.

Chairman LaFuria asked for public comments or concerns and none were received. A motion from August Neff and the second from Fredrick Shunk approved the minutes of the July 7th, 2025 meeting as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Bills were presented for July 1st – July 20th for approval and payment as follows:
