

NORTH EAST TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
MEETING
MONDAY, JUNE 15, 2026
9:00 AM

Chairman Russ LaFuria called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also in attendance were Supervisors Fredrick Shunk and August Neff along with Attorney Tim Wachter and Secretary Erica Carlstrom.

Chairman LaFuria asked for public comments or concerns and none were received. A motion from Fredrick Shunk and the second from Russ LaFuria approved the minutes of the June 1st, 2026 meeting as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Bills were presented for June 1st – June 14th for approval and payment as follows:

Total approved by a motion from August Neff and the second from Fredrick Shunk was \$239,232.84 and passed by unanimous vote.

New Business:

Jen Smith, representing Downtown North East, met with the Supervisors to discuss the placement of life-size artwork at the Conservation Park. The artwork is intended to provide visitors with a photo opportunity and a memorable keepsake of their visit with family and friends. The display would be located near the kiosk already located at the beach. Ms. Smith explained that the artwork would be mounted on a welded base, allowing it to be removed and stored during the winter months. Township Solicitor Tim Wachter asked whether the artwork would be donated to the Township by Downtown North East. This would allow the Township to assume ownership and, if the display becomes weathered, damaged, or otherwise unusable, dispose of it as necessary. Solicitor Wachter stated that he would prepare the appropriate documentation for the donation. Ms. Smith agreed to this arrangement.

Supervisor August Neff reported on the Township Clean Up Days as all reports were in and invoices paid. The total cost to the Township was \$11,615.96. He felt everything went well.

Supervisors entered into an executive session for a legal matter.

With all business concluded a motion to adjourn was received from Fredrick Shunk at 9:30 AM.
