

NORTH EAST TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
MEETING
MONDAY JUNE 1, 2026
7:30 PM

Chairman Russ LaFuria called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also, in attendance were Supervisor Fredrick Shunk, Attorney Tim Wachter, and Secretary Erica Carlstrom.

Chairman LaFuria asked for public comments or concerns, none were received. A motion from Fredrick Shunk and the second from Russ LaFuria approved the minutes of the May 18th, 2026 meeting as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Secretary Erica Carlstrom presented the Treasurer's report for the month of May 2026 and by motion from Fredrick Shunk and the second from Russ LaFuria was accepted as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Bills were presented for May 18th – May 31st, 2026, for approval and payment as follows:

Total approved by a motion from Russ LaFuria and the second from Fredrick Shunk was \$285,583.78 and passed by unanimous vote.

Old Business:

Tabled from the May 4th meeting was a Conditional Use Permit for Evandale Farms. The purpose of the conditional use is for agrotourism, they would like to have a fall festival. Attorney Andy Schmidt sent to the Supervisors his findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. After reviewing the findings Russ LaFuria made a motion to approve and sign the conditional use permit. Fredrick Shunk made the second motion. All in favor.

New Business:

Dave Thornton; is seeking final approval to consolidate multiple parcels into one. The parcels would consist of Windy Lane, Ruby Lane, and Brooke Lane. After reviewing the mylars Russ LaFuria made the motion to approve and sign. The second motion was received from Fredrick Shunk. All in favor.

Resolution #2026-013; appointment of Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC). Matt Skrekla was appointed as the Townships new EMC. A motion from Fredrick Shunk approving the appointing of Matt was made with the second from Russ LaFuria. Passed by unanimous vote.

Water/Sewer Supervisor Fredrick Shunk stated work on the Gravel Pit pavilion was started today and the time frame for getting it built would be approximately 2 weeks. Fredrick also wanted to make aware that water turn off's are happening on delinquent accounts.

After announcements and with all business concluded, a motion to adjourn at 7:50 PM was received from Fredrick Shunk. Meeting Adjourned.
