

NORTH EAST TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
MEETING
MONDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2017
9:00 AM

Chairman Fredrick Shunk called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also in attendance were Supervisors August Neff and Robert Mazza, Attorney Robert Jeffery, and Secretary Karen Ahlgrim. Members of the public included Jim Williams, Julia Gorniak, Fritz Holzhausen, Matt Putman, Karl and Nancy Larson and Aime Szymanski.

Chairman Shunk asked for public comments or concerns and none were received. A motion from Robert Mazza and the second from August Neff approved the minutes of the October 2, 2017 meeting as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Bills were presented for October 1st through October 15th, 2017 for approval and payment as follows:

Mr. Karl Larson of 6556 Macoun Way addressed the Board with concerns over the new lighting placed at the Lakeside Chevy dealer car lot. He resides 2.1 miles from the West Main Road/Route 20 business and notes how the light from the poles placed there shine onto his house and into windows. He had several sample ordinances on lighting noting ours is presently vague about lighting rules, he is part of the Dark Sky Initiative and in favor of down lighting. Supervisors noted several complaints have been received; Mr. Gabler of Lakeside was following General Motor minimum lumen specs but agrees and is trying to adjust the lights and add side shades. Mrs. Nancy Larson expressed concerns for migrating birds too. Supervisors will continue to follow this issue.

Mr. Matt Putman noted that Raccoon Refuse is now taking Township customers, and is reasonably priced.

Halloween hours have been set for Tuesday, October 31st from 6-8 pm. Flushing will occur on November 5th and 6th. Township offices and garage will be closed Election Day, November 7th.

After announcements a motion to adjourn at 9:10 am was received from Fredrick Shunk. Meeting adjourned.
