

NORTH EAST TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS
MEETING
MONDAY JULY 6, 2026
7:30 PM

Chairman Russ LaFuria called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Also, in attendance were Supervisors August Neff and Fredrick Shunk, and Secretary Erica Carlstrom.

Chairman LaFuria asked for public comments or concerns. Godfried Holzhausen asked when the lifeguard hours would be posted at Freeport Beach. Supervisor LaFuria responded that he would reach out to Jonathon Currier regarding the matter. North East resident Erin Tordoff asked the Supervisors whether anything could be done regarding the outdoor lighting on the RJ Corman building. She stated that the lights are not in compliance with the Township's lighting ordinance. Ms. Tordoff advised that she had contacted Code Enforcement Officer Jay Jobczynski but had not observed any action taken by the business. Supervisor LaFuria stated that he would speak with Mr. Jobczynski to determine the status of the matter. A motion from Fredrick Shunk and the second from August Neff approved the minutes of June 15th, 2026 meeting as presented and passed by unanimous vote. Secretary Erica Carlstrom presented the Treasurer's report for the month of June 2026 and by a motion from August Neff and the second from Russ LaFuria was accepted as presented and passed by unanimous vote.
